- "Reading interests" refers variously to the following: an individual's interest in doing **Reading** itself, as demonstrated by the amount of actual Reading done; what a reader wants to read "about" as expressed by a list of topics or subject areas or genres that the reader reads by preference; or the elements in a text, sometimes referred to as appeal factors, that engage a particular reader with a text.
- Increasing Reading interest improves the ability to understand the content. Students interested in reading conduct Reading activities because of their desire to obtain information. This means increasing reading interest improves comprehension abil- ities. The higher the Reading interest, the higher the comprehension.

A present study is adopted survey-based questionare method to use for data collection. The researcher distributed 280 questionare in college and received 248 questionare from students. 98 of female students and 150 male students. The data were summarized, and percentages were calculated.

#### **Review of litreature:**

Kumar et al. (2010) conducted a study on 'Reading habits of senior secondary students at Allahabad city, U.P., India'. The opinion is that reading is usually a private act, a personal and individual relationship with a book. A well-structured questionnaire was designed and used for collecting data. The results of their study revealed that a majority of the students and their reading motives included getting the information and improving their general knowledge.

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A Research on Reading Habits of University Students: (Sample of Ankara University and Erciyes University) Procedia - Social and Behavioural Sciences Volume 174, 12 February 2015, Pages 3983-3990. This study has the objective of determining the reading habits of students studying at the Ankara University Department of Primary Education and Erciyes University History Department. To that end, data of questionnaires applied to a total of 326 students consisting of 225 students from Ankara University and 101 students from Erciyes University have been analyzed and the results have been presented in the form of table According to the data obtained in the study, it has been determined that students at Ankara University and Erciyes University read novels, newspapers and magazines in their spare time, they enjoy reading literary works, historic, romantic, entertaining-humorous, and psychological genres the most, and they could not spare much time for reading books due to the intensity of lessons, busy social life, preparation for examinations and spending time on the computer/internet.

#### Baladhanandayuthham & suji (2014):

Explain and analyze the Reading Habit of the students. Awareness about Library, satisfaction of the Library, almost one third of respondents are initiated by librarians for reading habits.68.92 percent of the respondents agree to that Library is appropriate place for reading. Finally, the author concludes library is a storehouse of knowledge and the librarians are answerable to motivate people to utilise the library sources.

Acheaw and Larson (2014) conducted a study on reading habits among students and its effect on academic performance and the study adopted data collection for a questionnaire-based survey of Koforidua polytechnic students. The paper Explains the importance of reading they preferred 62.5 percent of respondents are reading novel or Fiction,14.9 percent of students specified to learn new thing and only 4 percent of students indicated reading is bored 62.0 percent of students opinion is that they read lecture notes when they visit the library facility,25.0%indicated they read textbooks, Finally the Authors conclude majority of the respondents had the view that reading habits have consequence on academic performance.

Vanenhoek (2013) describes screen reading habits among university students and author examine the common preferences and habits of university students and the study included online survey method with 630 students. The author find out majority of respondents preferred for paper reading and 74 percent of respondents replying in support of paper-based reading. More than 60 percent of respondents like print less than 30 percent of student read article.
